PURPOSE OF MEETING

The purpose of the meeting is to review the proposed library interior layout with the Principal and the Librarian and to obtain additional feedback in order to finalize the interior layout. (See attached for the library interior layout presented.)

ITEMS DISCUSSED/ACTION ITEMS

- 1. Provide carpet as the floor finish at the library interior.
- 2. Remove window adjacent to the main entry door due to security issue.
- 3. Provide solid door. No vision window on the door.
- 4. Provide workroom/storage area adjacent to the Librarian's desk.
- 5. Provide minimum (8) eight computer stations. The Librarian likes a few of them to be located at the end of the bookcase at the book stack area.

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- 6. Provide a sink similar to the one at the existing library.
- 7. Provide bookcases at the storytelling area.
- 8. The following existing furniture items are to be relocated to the proposed Library building. (See the attached photos for the noted furniture items)
 - 1. (3) Double sided bookcases at 5'-0" high.
 - 2. (2) 4-drawer filing cabinets
 - 3. (2) E-Z view storage benches
 - 4. (2) Double sided canvas book display

Any existing furniture items not mentioned above will either be discarded or will remain in the existing library.

- 9. The Principal and Librarian accept and approve the window option presented.
- 10. The Principal and Librarian accept and approve the barrel vault ceiling presented.
- 11. The Principal and Librarian accept and approve the storytelling benches presented.
- 12. The current book check out system is Follett, Destiny.
- 13. Need to confirm with the District if the book detection system is required at the door entry.
- 14. The Librarian would like to have power, phone, and data located at her desk and to be able to connect her computer to present materials onto the projection screen.
- 15. Need to verify with Steve Brinkman the technology standards, projectors, and TV hook-up for audio and video standards.
- 16. Architect to revise the Library interior layout.
