1.01	Info	The meeting was held to discuss the scope of work for the Madison Elementary Modernization project with the school's site council and the District Administration.			
1.02	Info	Steve Brinkman presented the following funding sources for Madison.

1.03	Info	The project construction budget was established at \$18,498,310. This includes contingencies through the end of construction.			
1.04	Info	The District will vote on a central kitchen concept at the April 28, 2009 board meeting. That decision will affect the scope of the work at the Madison kitchen.			
1.05	PUSD	The Architect's list of projects for the site included Item L, a new Kindergarten Building. The District will determine its status.			

The school staff presented a list of items that they wanted to be addressed.

Info

- The existing wood windows are deteriorated, glazed with plastic, and in some cases boarded.
- The delivery area for trucks was not separated from the campus traffic. 2.
- There are not enough parking stalls (40 with 2 being accessible stalls) for the 70 staff that works on the site daily.
- The public address system does not reach the Pre-Kindergarten or the Portable Buildings.
- The fence around the school is varying heights and is in poor condition. A uniform fence 10-foot high was requested.
- The flooring in the restrooms at the new building retains odors and is not hygienic.
- 7. The bells, phone and clock system is in poor condition.
- There is no storage space in any of the classrooms. Tall cabinets with locks were requested.
- The emergency exit stairs at the west of Building A are steep and may not be safe in an emergency.
- 10. The Kindergarten building's arched openings should be restored.
- 11. A ramp at the front of the school would help mothers with strollers.
- 12. City owned parkway landscaping is not maintained by the City and is constant need or replanting.
- 1.07 Info Steve Brinkman submitted a list of projects identified by GKK Works (attached). 1.08 The site council prioritized the scope of work as follows:
  - 1. Provide shade structures for the lunch area, playgrounds and Kindergarten playground.
  - 2. Replace drinking fountains throughout the campus, add fountains where needed.
  - 3. Replace the plumbing fixtures in the kitchen and restrooms. Provide new flooring in the new building restrooms.
  - 4. Replace old electrical panels at the basement of Building A and provide exterior lighting throughout the campus.
  - 5. Provide a trash enclosure near the kitchen. Create a delivery area for trucks.
  - 6. Create a drop-off on the north side of the campus. Increase parking capacity.
  - 7. Restore the auditorium to its historical prominence and make accessible from Ashtabula Street.
  - 8. Provide ventilation to the library space.
- 1.09 Info The Healthy Start director presented a list of concerns (attached) with the building used for this program.
- 1.10 Info Project scope requested by the District includes:
  - 1. Separation of the domestic water, fire water and irrigation water.

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2. Seismic Upgrades to the Main Classroom Building and the Kitchen Building.

1.11 Info Scope suggested by the Architect is to irrigate the City owned parkway around the campus.

1.12 PUSD/DD The architect and the District will meet to finalize scope of work.
