Assessment Summary:

Marshall, like Blair, is a secondary school offering middle through high school education. As a high school facility, it is eligible for the district wide provision of installation of an artificial track and turf for its playground facilities. Its curb-appeal stems, as in most district school buildings, from its historical architectural style and a manicured front lawn.

Identified maintenance issues which need to be addressed as part of a deferred maintenance and modernization programs include the following:

Modernization of the Cafeteria, Kitchen, including the Lunch Shelter, the Auditorium and Gymnasium Locker Rooms; provision of accessible paths of travel, including ramps to the Main Classroom Building and playfields from Allen Ave.; replacement of electrical panel boards as well as the bell, telephone, and clock systems; and the separation of domestic, fire, and irrigation water meters.

Other concerns identified were the need to provide security measures as exterior lighting throughout and fencing separating the instructional building area from the fields and playgrounds which are used on weekends and off-school hours; provision of student parking coupled with improved student drop-off areas inside the campus borders; replacement of main quad paving; and replacement of the front marquee with a new and taller one.
