DISCUSSION ITEMS ACTION ITEM NO. 1.01 Mr. Brinkman introduced LPA, Inc. as the selected architecture Info firm to implement the Measure TT work. Mr. Brinkman stated that purpose for today's meeting is for the School Site Council to review and prioritize the "Comprehensive Facilities Master Plan" list of Immediate Needs. Info 1.02 Mr. Brinkman reported that the total program budget for McKinley School is 39,680,433. This amount includes money to modernize the cafeteria building. The District recently approved the construction of a District wide central kitchen. To fund this project, a portion of the cafeteria modernization budgets for all schools, including McKinley School will be allocated for this Central Kitchen project. Info 1.03 M. Sarian distributed the priority listings dated January 9, 2009 (attached). This list reflects the sites priorities. 1.04 The sites highest priority is to "Reconstruct entire gym building...". Info This aligns with the District priority to initiate this gym along with the gym building at Washington MS ahead of the remaining projects.
