Assessment Summary:

Muir High School is planning for a future change in its instructional program which will introduce spatial reassignments and generate physical alterations and improvements. Classroom will be regrouped to accommodate three new Career Academies: Arts/Media/Entertainment, Engineering/Environmental Science, and Business Entrepreneurship.

However, areas identified as needing immediate upgrading and/or reconstruction included: modernization of the Cafeteria and Kitchen spaces; modernization of the Gymnasium spaces, particularly the locker rooms, pools and pool decks, and interior basketball courts. Playgrounds and athletic fields, including the bleachers, must be made accessible and provided with ADA drinking fountains and other related amenities. As in other district high schools, Muir would be in line to receive new artificial track and field improvements.

In terms of long range planning, the Planning Team has introduced suggested site modifications based on identified school needs and projected school goals related to the Academy concept and possible creation of Career Technology Education hubs. These include the redistribution of the parking areas to accommodate proximity to learning hubs, including creation of new parking on the abandoned street section adjacent to the gymnasium complex; creation of a quad system based on the Small Community Learning Center concept; and modification of the Main Quad through the use of re-landscaping and provisions of permanent shade structures.
