### Assessment Summary:

As in Willard Elementary, which faces Wilson Middle School across the street, external appearance upgrades, including repainting and window replacement are identified as an immediate need which will be addressed on the next deferred maintenance and modernization program. Other “curb-appeal” issues have already been implemented as it is evident in the resurfacing of the tennis courts which face Madre Street on the southwest corner of campus.

Immediate needs consist of the modernization of the Main Building, the Cafeteria, Kitchen and Auditorium, including its Band Room, as well as many existing restrooms throughout the campus. The gymnasium’s elevator will need to be repaired and the locker rooms modernized.

Other main improvements include upgrading of the school’s electrical, mechanical, and plumbing infrastructure wherever it is needed.

Wilson MS, a community shared facility, avails the use of its track and field as well as its tennis courts during school off-hours and on weekends. As in Eliot MS, there is a secondary need to upgrade its fencing system and introduce other security measures as outdoor lighting throughout. Replacement of dilapidated field bleachers is recommended.
